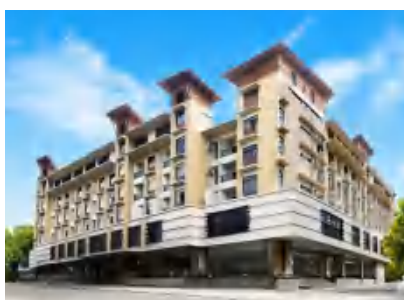

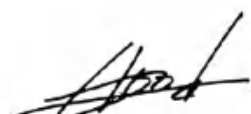

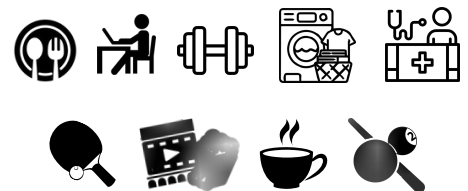
LOCATION

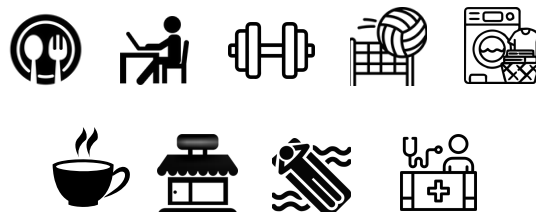
Placement Test

Rules And Regulations | CEBU



General Provisions

1. Designation

The official name of the institution is SMEAG Global Education. The 1st Campus shall be referred to as Capital, the 2nd Campus shall be referred to as Encanto, and the international school located in Tarlac shall be referred to as SMEAG Global School.

2. By laws Agreement

Students are required to sign the Academic and Administrative Agreement before starting their course at SMEAG Global Education. By signing the agreement, students agree to comply with all school rules and regulations.

3. Studying lifestyle

Students can live freely as long as they follow the school regulations. Before arriving at SMEAG, students must have travel insurance or international student insurance to ensure their safety. SMEAG will not be held liable for any damages resulting from a lack of insurance.

4. Refunds after expulsion

No refund will be made in cases of expulsion due to student misconduct. Deposits will not be refunded if the expulsion occurs during the final week of enrollment, and the deposit will be donated under the student's name.

5. Responsibility

The school is not responsible for any matters concerning students after their graduation or expulsion.

6. Registration and Extensions

- 6.1 There is a one-time, non-refundable registration fee of \$100.
- 6.2 Within five business days (excluding legal holidays) after the application is submitted, an invoice will be issued. All tuition and dormitory fees must be paid in full at least two weeks before the start of enrollment.
- 6.3 For course extensions, students must inform the Administration Office and apply at least four weeks before their expected graduation date. Payment must be completed no later than two weeks prior to the first day of the extension period. Failure to make payment by this deadline will result in automatic cancellation of the extension.
- 6.4 After registration and before the start of the course, the departure date can be changed only once. A service charge of \$100 will apply for any additional changes, and the dormitory or study period cannot be changed under any circumstances.
- 6.5 Tuition fees cannot be forwarded or transferred under any circumstances.
- 6.6 Students are responsible for the additional costs of services below:
 - a) Visa extension fee : The visa extension fee must be paid to the Philippine Bureau of Immigration and will vary depending on the student's length of stay. Students are required to pay the full amount in advance.
 - b) SSP fee (Special Study Permit) : The SSP is required to obtain certification that maintains a student's legal status to study in the Philippines.
 - c) ACR I-CARD issuance : The ACR I-CARD is an identification card issued by the Philippine Bureau of Immigration to foreign students staying in the Philippines. It serves to verify the student's identity and legal status.
 - d) Course and Dormitory change fee : Extensions, course changes, or dormitory transfers may incur additional charges in accordance with SMEAG policies.
 - e) Other Expenses : Travel costs, medical expenses, telephone bills, electricity and water charges, and personal allowances are the sole responsibility of the student.
- 6.7 Students are required to indicate any allergies, medical conditions, or disabilities on their application form to ensure the safety of all students and staff. In cases of serious medical conditions, SMEAG reserves the right to refuse the application.

7. REFUND POLICY

- 7.1 Pre-departure
 - a) Students may receive a full refund if they cancel at least 2 weeks prior to their scheduled departure date. However, the registration fee will not be refundable.
 - b) If students cancel from 14 days to 4 days before departure, they will receive a refund equivalent to 2 weeks of room and board fees.
 - c) If students cancel within 3 days of their scheduled departure date, they will be charged for 1 week of tuition fees and 4 weeks of dormitory fees.

- 7.2 After departure
 - a) If students want to cancel upon arrival at SMEAG, 60% of the total fees will be refunded.
 - b) After starting the study period, refund is available in a 4 week basis and 60% will be refundable.
 - c) All refund amounts will be processed within 30 days and given by SMEAG.
 - d) If students are absent for 3 weeks from opening date, without advance notice, no refund will be given.
 - e) If students arrive later than the opening date or miss classes, no refund and make-up class will be given.

- f) If students enroll in a guarantee course for more than 12 weeks, they are eligible for a 60% refund of the remaining period beyond the initial 12 weeks, after completing the required official exam.

8. Holding Period Policy

- 8.1 Students may request a holding period if there are at least 4 weeks remaining in their enrollment period.
- 8.2 SMEAG will deduct 2 weeks (tuition and board) from the total duration and students can restart within 6 months.
- 8.3 VISA extension fee and SSP issuance fee are non-refundable. If students require an extension or a new SSP issuance (valid for 6 months) after the holding period, it is the student's responsibility to reapply and cover the cost.
- 8.4 Dormitory selection after returning from the holding period will be subject to availability.
- 8.5 Airport pick-up service will not be available during the holding period.

9. Disclaimer Policy

- 9.1 SMEAG and its authorized agents shall not be held liable for any canceled or delayed flights caused by natural disasters or other events beyond SMEAG's control.
- 9.2 SMEAG is not liable for any accidents occurring outside SMEAG premises when such incidents happen without SMEAG's involvement or approval.
- 9.3 SMEAG is not responsible for any damage to property, personal injury, or loss of life that may occur while traveling, going out, or staying outside the campus.
- 9.4 Classes are conducted five days a week. However, SMEAG does not provide compensation for Philippine national holidays, temporary school closures, or special holidays.
- 9.5 SMEAG has the authority to change its prices to adhere to the (6 months) exchange rate and tax increase in accordance with the relevant laws of the Philippines government. If necessary, SMEAG can change the opening date or course curriculum & program for better quality of study.

- 9.6 SMEAG has the right to expel students who break the rules and regulations of the school. Students who have absences without permission, commit acts of violence, bad attitude will be grounds for expulsion to maintain a positive academic atmosphere.
- 9.7 If students lead a meeting or gather a group for bad purposes and would cause SMEAG damages, SMEAG has the right to expel those students without any warning and ask for a compensation.
- 9.8 When students are expelled, SMEAG may notify the student's parents and authorized agents regarding the decision.

Academic Policy

1. Class Attendance and Class Changing

- 1.1 SMEAG has the sole discretion in arranging classes and teachers. Students cannot make objections without valid reasons.
- 1.2 Students must be in their classrooms within 5 minutes after the bell. Otherwise they will be marked as absent.
- 1.3 In order to maintain professionalism in the classroom, students are required to refrain from wearing short skirts or shorts and/or flip flops.
- 1.4 Students are allowed to change classes once in every 2 weeks. If students want to change the class, he/she must fill out a change of class form with Students Assistant (SA) teachers on Thursday until 6PM. Priority for teachers will be decided in consideration of attendance, warnings and study duration. Students can start their reassigned schedule the following week on Monday.
- 1.5 If there is a problem with a class due to a labor strike, unexpected circumstances or absences/ early dismissal/ tardiness of teachers, a substitute teacher will be provided.
- 1.6 It is only possible for students to be absent due to sickness, changing of flight, receipt of postal package with manager's permission in advance. The students will be required to submit an objective data, such as doctor's certificate or postal receipt.
- 1.7 There will be a charge of 500 pesos for course changing after students start their course in the school, and when it is not scheduled registration in advance.

2. Sparta Class and Weekly Mock Test Attendance

- 2.1 All students who arrive at SMEAG must be in accordance with the provisions of each campus and attend morning and evening Sparta classes.
- 2.2 Students whose attendance rate falls below 90% may be subject to penalties in accordance with SMEAG regulations.
- 2.3 Sparta classes will begin on the evening of the second day after arrival.
- 2.4 All SMEAG students must take a weekly test in accordance with the regulations of each campus.
- 2.5 Students who fail to take the weekly test will be subject to an academic warning in accordance with SMEAG's academic regulations.

3. SMEAG Graduate Certificate

A graduate certificate will be issued to students in their final week of study if they have attended more than 80% of their classes. Students with an attendance rate below 80% will not be eligible for a graduate certificate.

Admin Regulations

1. Dormitory Regulations

- 1.1 Dormitory room assignment is a unique privilege of SMEAG. All students must stay in the assigned room unless there is an acceptable valid reason for change.
- 1.2 Students who wish to change their rooms due to personal reasons will be charged 500 pesos. (For campus transfers, 500 pesos will be charged from the 2nd attempt to change)
- 1.3 All students must reside in dormitory upon arrival at SMEAG and sign the dormitory agreement form. Failure to abide by the rules and regulations of the dormitory agreement may result in expulsion.
- 1.4 Personal toiletries will not be provided by SMEAG and are the responsibility of the student.
- 1.5 If an SMEAG employee has been accused of theft, SMEAG will not be held liable until after a thorough investigation by authorities has been made.
- 1.6 All furniture is the sole property of SMEAG. Students who damage any property or remove them from the school will be held responsible for full reimbursement.
- 1.7 Cooking and eating food are prohibited in dormitory room and public space in order to prevent fire problem, or harmful insect and these behaviors can result to a warning and expulsion. Student can eat in the dining area or canteen only

2. Deposit Regulations

- 2.1 Upon arrival at SMEAG, an Initial 2,500 pesos of room deposit must be made in order to protect the property of the school and amount is refundable if there is no issues.
- 2.2 P300 key deposit must be made upon arrival. Since the door lock must be changed if a key is lost, the deposit is fully refundable when the key is returned.
- 2.3 P200 of E-Money Card deposit must be made upon arrival. E-Money Card deposit will be refundable if students return the card.
- 2.4 Students are responsible for paying water and electric bill at the end of every month. Electric bill will be made by members of the room depending on usage amount. Water bill will be charged 10 pesos per day. Students can check the electric meter when they are assigned in a room.

3. Curfew and Visit Regulations

- 3.1 All students must strictly follow to the curfew regulations. The curfew hours are set from 11:00 PM to 5:00 AM, applicable on both weekdays and weekends.
- 3.2 Students are strictly prohibited from entering the opposite gender's room. This will cause immediate expulsion from the school if they cross the red line.
- 3.3 Outside visitors are strictly checked by SMEAG security guards. Even though they get a permit to enter from SMEAG, they are not allowed to enter the dormitory.

4. Alcohol Drinking & Smoking Prohibitions

- 4.1 liquor/alcoholic beverages inside the campus is strictly prohibited. Violent behavior, vandalism, disturbance of peace or fights after drinking will result to warning or expulsion according to the regulations of SMEAG.
- 4.2 In order to keep a pleasant dormitory environment and prevent the risk of fire, smoking is only permitted in designated areas. If a student is caught smoking in the room or throwing away the cigarette butts, it will result to a warning and they will be charged 1,000 pesos as penalty.

5. Cleaning & Laundry

- 5.1 Housekeeping service will be provided once a week and beddings will be changed when the room is being cleaned. If there is a proper reason, students may ask the office for a change of beddings.
- 5.2 Laundry service is available everyday. After cleaning, laundry will be delivered to the laundry baskets located next to each room. If there are delicate or expensive clothes, laundry can be rejected and SMEAG is not responsible for any color damage or alterations. Any lost or damaged items will be reasonably compensated.

6. Warning, Penalties and Grounds of Expulsion

- 6.1 Students will be expelled without a warning if they enter the opposite gender's room or are caught drinking in rooms, or damage the pride of SMEAG with any improper reasons.
- 6.2 Students will receive warnings and may face expulsion if their attendance rate is less than 90%, cause excessive noise inside the campus or commit violent acts towards each other threatens.
- 6.3 Receiving 5 warnings will result in expulsion.

Dormitory Rules and Regulations

1. To become a healthy citizen, contribute to society, love to each other and be cooperative.
2. To create an atmosphere that can be dedicated to promoting education and providing a foundation for self-realization.
3. To build an upright personality through dormitory life by learning care for each other and be considerate of the feelings of others.

*SMEAG Global school enforces the following dormitory rules and regulation for every student to abide by.

1. Basic Dormitory Guidelines.

The dormitory is a place for students to improve and form a good moral character, thus, the following regulations must be followed to maintain peace and order to create the best learning environment;

- 1-1 Every student in the dormitory should be proud of being in SMEAG Global School and do his or her best to improve both academic ability and good moral character.
- 1-2 Every student in required to fulfill his or her roles as a student and does not ask for any exceptions.
- 1-3 Every student should cultivate cultural awareness of citizens by keeping order lines and do his or her best not because other students any inconvenience.
- 1-4 Every student must not damage the facilities of dormitory and use them with good care.
- 1-5 Every student must understand and comply with the dormitory rules and regulations and also follow the instructions of a dormitory manager.
- 1-6 Every student should respect each other and greets with smile and also be polite to the dormitory employees.
- 1-7 Every student must show a warm spirit of comradeship and teamwork by thinking of 'we' first rather than 'I' and be the first one when others are in need of help.
- 1-8 Every student is expected to use positive language and be polite and kind to school employees, parents, visitors and classmates.
- 1-9 All the facilities and equipment of the dormitory belong to the school property, thus, if a student ever happens to destroy any of those, he or she will be asked to compensate for its loss.
- 1-10 Any gathering or entertainment without permission is not allowed. Smart phones, notebooks, cartoons, pornographic photos and fantasy novels which have possibilities of hindering the learning environment cannot be carried and disseminated inside the dormitory.
- 1-11 It is not allowed to cook in any place in the dormitory.
- 1-12 In order for every student to have sound sleep and heighten the efficiency of learning, things which can disrupt others must be avoided such as having a chat, waling around, doing the laundry and taking a shower after 2:00.
- 1-13 Running and heavy walk around the dormitory.
- 1-14 It is not allowed to walk around the dormitory wearing underwear.
- 1-15 Every student must wear complete school uniform while in classes and also be in neat clothes while sleeping.
- 1-16 Room arrangement will be planned by a manager every semester.
- 1-17 Every student is not allowed to use his or her mobile phone during the week. The phones will be given to students every Friday at 22:00 and be surrendered again every Sunday at 22:00. If this rules is not kept, a student will be imposed with penalty points and will be grounded on the weekend. (In case of a holiday, the phone will be given the day before at 22:00)
- 1-18 It is absolutely banned to drink and smoke inside the campus.

2. Personal hygiene and healthcare

- 2-1 Every student is anticipated to take a shower everyday and maintain neat in order not to cause other people unpleasant feelings.
- 2-2 The bedding should be washed and changed regularly to observe cleanliness.
- 2-3 Be punctual with meal times and do not skip meals.
- 2-4 In case of emergency, report it to a school staff immediately.
- 2-5 To say physically fit, every student is expected to live a well-regulated life and exercise.
- 2-6 Every student should get enough sleep in order not to harm his or her health.

3. Living in a dormitory room

- 3-1 The first priority of a room is to take a rest sleep; therefore any act of disturbance such as parties is prohibited.
- 3-2 All the facilities in the room like cabinets, beds, and trashcans should not be damaged in any case.
- 3-3 Every student should always check the facilities such as air conditioner and furniture. If anything damage is found, report it to the school maintenance for fixing.
- 3-4 Its is not desirable to throw any garbage out of the window. (Do not try to force the mosquito net to open the window)
- 3-5 Its is banned to bring any food(noodles, pizza, fast food and cake) inside the room to maintain cleanliness of the room. (Food must be kept in a container at a designated area)
- 3-6 The cabinet has to be locked all the time. If a student needs to keep his or her money or valuables with a manager, he or she might ask for it.
- 3-7 The lights in the room should be switched off at 23:00 to sleep.
- 3-8 The air conditioner and the lights should be turned off when going out. (If not, penalty points will be given)
- 3-9 No visitors (classmates or friends) are allowed to be in the rooms.
- 3-10 Every student is required to buy his or her own toiletries and never to other's.

4. Using the student lounge

- 4-1 Take good care of the facilities (microphones, remote controls and speakers) in the lounge and never destroy them.
- 4-2 Every student should strictly follow the time schedule of the operating hours.
- 4-3 When going out of the lounge, the lights, air conditioner and electronic equipment must be turned off.
- 4-4 It is banned to bring any food inside the lounge.
- 4-5 Every student must keep an eye on his or her valuables (Management will not be liable for any losses).

5. Laundry guide

- 5-1 The laundry should be put in a personal basket and placed in front of the room in accordance with the laundry time schedule (before going to school).
- 5-2 Every student should put a name tag on his or her personal clothes in order not to be mixed with others.

6. Sleeping out and going out

- 6-1 It is strictly restricted to sleep out and go out in order to build up good learning environment and maintain an orderly community life.
- 6-2 It is only allowed to go out on the weekend and holiday in accordance with the shuttle schedule.
*Going out is impossible if a student cannot allow the shuttle schedule. If student ever happens to be late for the schedule, he or she will be given penalty points.
- 6-3 It is not allowed to wear slippers when going out, every student must wear a pair of shoes and be in neat outfit.

7. Roll call

There are "Morning Roll Call", "Night Roll Call" and Special Roll Call".

- 7-1 The morning roll call starts at 8:00. If a student is late or skips it, the penalty points will be given and the student will be grounded.

- 7-2 The night roll call starts at 22:30.

- 7-3 The special roll call can be carried out anytime upon the decision of a dormitory manager.

8. Preparation for entering a school dormitory

- 8-1 Beddings are provided.
- 8-2 Clothes: Every student should have at least 4 pairs of clothing.
- 8-3 Personal toiletries: Shampoo, soap, tooth brush, tooth paste, towel, lotion, cup and toilet paper
- Additional purchase could be done in both Korean and local groceries nearby SMEAG Global School.
- 8-4 Learning materials: if needed, prepare personal storing device like a USB.
- 8-5 Cash or debit card: any card which has VISA mark is possible.
- 8-6 A pair of house shoes/slippers which causes little sound when walking.
- 8-7 Personal laundry baskets are provided.
- 8-8 Using electronic devices for learning and mobile phones (on a day-off only) is possible but be cautious with the risk of loss.
- 8-9 Prohibited items
 1. Electronic item such as fans, irons, electric blankets, lamp, lantern and products or inflammables like heaters, matches and lighters.
 2. Cartoons and unsound books etc. which are not related to learning.
 3. Big things which have to be put on the floor and can infringe the lives of others(bookshelves, clothes box and table etc.)
 4. Any kind of gambling cards (Hwatoo학투) and deadly weapons
 5. Awls or screw drivers which can destroy the texture of ceiling

11. Others

- Dress neatly when going to school.
- Be on time with school time schedule.
- When there are issues regarding facilities or other concerns, report it to the managers.
- Try by our best to conserve energy such as electricity and water.

The following are additional rules aside from the dormitory rules and regulations

Every student must obey these rules to make our school better and create a pleasant living environment.

1. Observe silence inside the dormitory

1. Don't make any noise when walking, cautiously open and close the door, speak softly, and don't run.
2. Walking on the hallway and visiting others are banned after 11 p.m.

2. Be polite to everyone around you and greet others with a smile.

3. Cleanliness and tidiness

1. Open the window and air out right after waking up / making the bed/ cleaning the room / empty trashcans
2. Do not throw any garbage
3. Use the water dispenser properly (do not spill the water on the floor and wash your cups)

4. Using the students lounge

1. Turn off the lights, air conditioner and water when going out of the room.
2. Eat food as much as you can during the meal time.
3. Don't put any recyclable things in the trashcan (Separate them and recycle)

5. Personal hygiene

1. Bedding: Change blanket and line once a week.
Atopic dermatitis patients should change the bedding more frequently.
2. Keep your body clean: whenever entering your own room, wash your hands with soap. (Keep in mind that the infectious diseases like eye infection can harm others)
